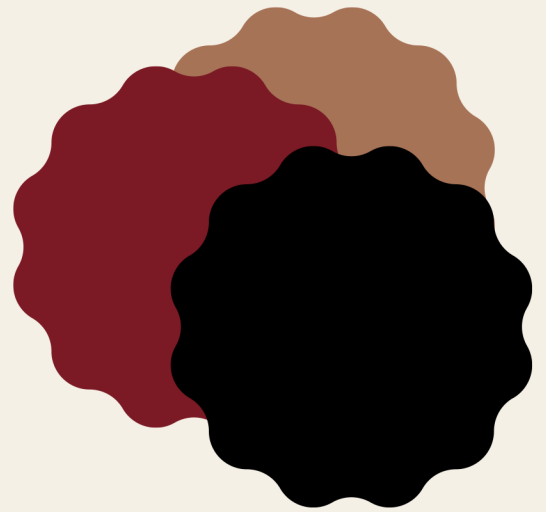


Improve educational equity and avoid litigation



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EL Legal literacy is the ability to evaluate real-life situations, identify the legal issues, and employ the applicable legal laws and principles to appropriately resolve the legal problems.

Focus on the law first - not strategies.

School districts have an obligation to ensure meaningful communication in a language parents understand: this includes activities, programs and services.

Areas of non compliance with communication include: not providing translation or interpretation or utilizing students to interpret etc.
